

Enrollment Instructions: **National Adoption Competency Mental Health Training Initiative:** **Mental Health Professionals**


1. Begin at the home page of the current E-Learning portal. Use this address:
<http://training.vermontcwtp.org/>
2. Once here, click on the link **Access these trainings at our companion site here.** in the gray box on the left of the home page; (See picture below)
3. You do not need to login to this site. You will navigate to the new site without logging in here and will be prompted to login or create a new account once on the new site.
